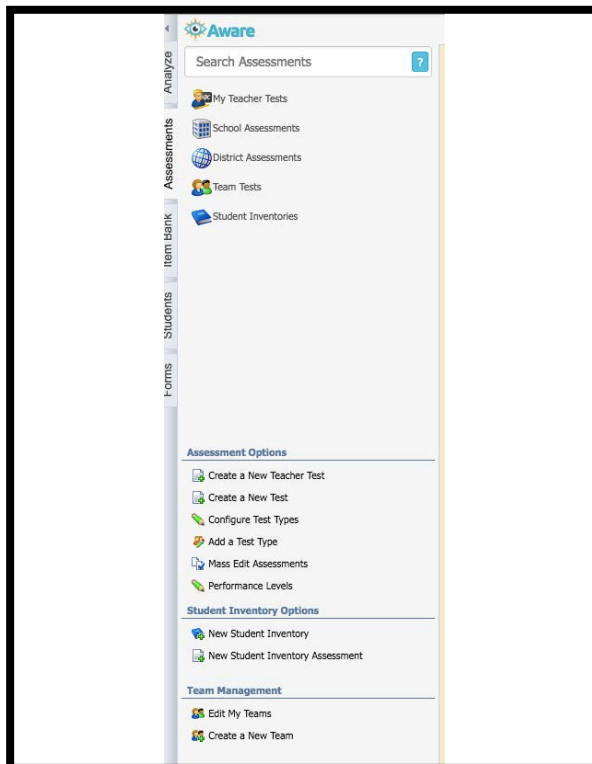


Using the TEKSBank Item Bank

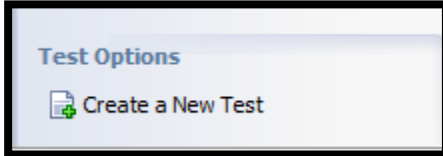
1. Login to Eduphoria, as usual. Select 'Aware' from the Applications homepage.



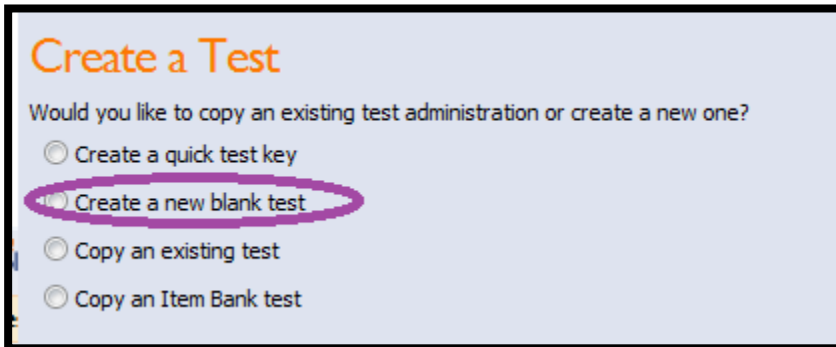
2. Select Assessments Tab



3. Click on 'Create a New Test' in the bottom left-hand corner.




4. A wizard will open up. To build a test from scratch, using the Teksbank items, select 'Create a new blank test', and click on the 'Next' button in the bottom right-hand corner.



5. Give your test a name and select the appropriate grade level from the drop-down list. Click 'Next'.
6. Select the appropriate subject from the folder system. Click 'Next'.
7. The wizard will now tell you, 'You're Done!' Click on the 'Finish' button in the bottom right-hand corner.

8. Your test editor will now open up on the screen. To build your test, select the 'Questions' tab near the center of your screen:

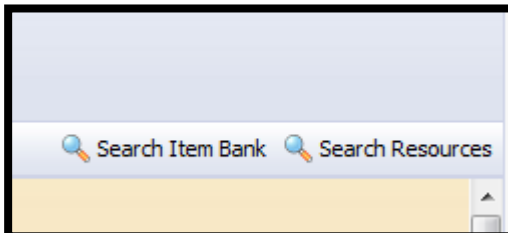

9. To find Teksbank items, select the 'Search Item Bank' button in the top, right-hand corner:

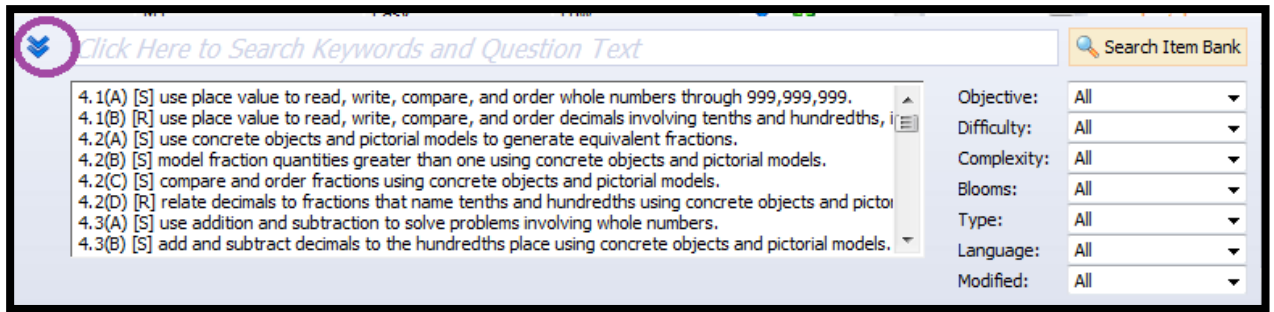
12. You can use the green circle with the plus sign to add it to your test. The plus sign will change to a checkmark to denote its addition to the assessment. If there are any associated graphics, resources, or passages, those will also be added to the test at this time. They do not need to be added separately.

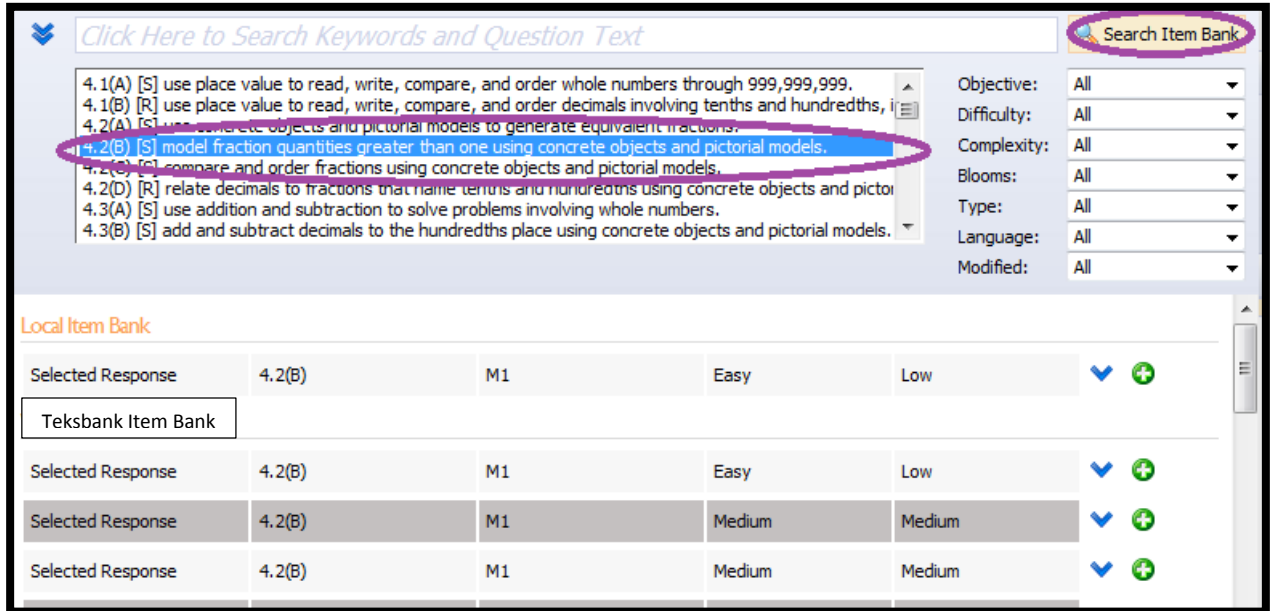

13. The best way to search the item bank is by using the advanced options. To view these, click on the two double blue arrows on the left-hand side. This will allow you to search by SE, as well as

give you several other options to narrow down your selections.



14. To view associated questions, select an SE (one at a time), then click on 'Search Item Bank'.



15. You can preview and add questions just as you added them earlier, by clicking on the blue arrow and green plus sign.

16. When you are done, click on 'Close' in the bottom left-hand corner to close the Item Bank. You should now be able to view your test as it would print.

17. To edit or remove a question, hover your mouse over the item and select the green pencil icon. A new editing window will drop down. You can make changes to the question or click 'Remove' in the bottom right-hand corner to remove it completely.
