

College Readiness Requirements for Dual Credit

High School Students are eligible to enroll in dual or concurrent credit courses after completing their sophomore year (freshmen and sophomores are allowed one course if approved by high school administrator and meet requirements) if the student demonstrates college readiness by achieving the minimum passing standards for STAAR or SAT or ACT or TSIA2.

**STAAR scores can only be used for high school students taking dual credit.
Scores indicate the lowest score to meet TSIA2 requirements.*
