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Classroom supplies

Each student will need a spiral notebook, 3-brad folder with pockets, notebook paper, and pencils. Mac books will also be needed. Calculators (TI-84 Plus) will be provided as supplies last, but students are welcome to bring their own.

Grading Policy

All GRHS math courses will use the following to determine six weeks average:

Daily assignments 30%, Test grades 70%

Grades will be updated in Skyward as quickly as possible – at least weekly. Periodically, students will be given a quiz which will count as a daily grade. The average of these quizzes will then count as an additional test grade. In addition to at least two major tests, students will have an assignment folder for a test grade, as well as a spiral test (over their notes from the six weeks). LOTS OF OPPORTUNITIES TO BE SUCCESSFUL!

Late work

Daily assignments will typically be due two days following the day assigned: for example, a Monday assignment will be not considered late until after class on Wednesday. This will provide an opportunity to return the next day with questions.

Many assignments will be able to be completed in class. Students can always turn them in day of, or take home for parents to check.

GR high school math department late work policy is one day -21 pts, two days -35 pts, three days -50 pts.

Re-Testing

In the event a student fails a test, a re-test will be made available in a timely manner, provided the student satisfies other requirements of the teacher (corrections, tutorials, etc.).

Absent work

Students involved in extra-curricular activities should plan ahead and be prepared to complete and turn in work on time.

Other absences will be given an extra day to complete and turn in their assignments.
