

Key things to remember for the Tuffy Tryout

- 1-2 minute long skit
- Must include the song eye of the tiger
 - Marching band or real band
 - Can only be a portion of the song, does not need to be the entire song
- Remember, the skit is to tell a story, usually of triumph! Tuffy always faces and then overcomes adversity. Your skit, should tell that story.
- Props need to be light and easy to move/carry but big enough that they match the size of tuffy.
 - Props can be bought, or handmade
- There are two ways to handle the music. You can edit it all together using a music editor, or on the students macbook, have the portion of each music/sound ready to push play.
- If you are using cheerleader candidates in your skit, make sure to include them from day 1! This way, you will have more time to practice and perfect the skit.
- Your cheerleader candidates will set up your props for your tryout
- Get creative! There is no right or wrong way to tryout!
