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**GEOMETRY** is probably the most applicable of all of the mathematics courses. We will discuss angles, lines, area of surfaces, volumes of figures, etc.

**CLASSROOM SUPPLIES** needed are a **spiral notebook, 3-brad folder with pockets, notebook paper, and pencils.** Calculators (TI-84 Plus) will be provided in class. MacBooks will need to be brought to class each day.

**GRADING POLICY** of all GRHS math courses for each six weeks will be the following:

**Daily assignments 30%, Test grades 70%**

Grades will be updated in Skyward as quickly as possible – at least weekly.

Periodically, students will be given a **QUIZ** which will count as a daily grade. The average of these quizzes will then count as an additional test grade. In addition to at least two major **TEST** grades, students will have a test over their notes each six weeks.

**Daily assignments** will typically be done electronically on Big Ideas. The main purpose of each daily assignment is to prepare students for the next quiz and/or test. Most assignments will be able to be completed in class. Our **textbook** is also available through Big Ideas.

GRHS math department **late work** policy is one day -21 pts, two days -35, three days -50.

**Re-Testing** will be made available in the event a student fails a test, provided the student satisfies other requirements of the teacher (corrections, tutorials, etc.).

**Make-up Work:** Students involved in extra-curricular activities should plan ahead and be prepared to complete and turn in work on time.

Other absences will be given an extra day to complete and turn in their assignments.

**ALL ASSIGNMENTS, AS WELL AS MOST QUIZZES AND TESTS, WILL BE AVAILABLE ONLINE THROUGH BIG IDEAS, rather than Canvas.**

**When students are absent, they should always check BIG IDEAS on their MacBooks – as well as in the case of an emergency shutdown.**

**TUTORIALS** will be made available on an as-needed basis.
