Class Information: This is an introductory class to Physics and Chemistry

Retaking a failing grade on an assignment

Retesting is permitted only under the following conditions:

Student received a failing grade on the unit test of the first attempt. There will be no retesting to bring up a passing grade.

All assignments that relate to the test must be completed.

Students must attend at least one tutorial session outside of class to go over missed questions on the original.

Retest must be scheduled and completed prior to the end of the 6 weeks in which the original test was given

The retest will not be the same test questions as the first test.

The highest possible replacement grade on a retest is 70.
