This class is a dual enrollment class between GRHS and UT Austin. Students will be enrolled in both schools for this class. It is a great opportunity for the students to get

college class experience while still receiving high school support in the classroom. Onramps Biology uses a flipped classroom + student engagement/cooperative learning styles. Students will receive a college grade, that at the end of the course can choose to accept AND a high school grade. It is possible for those grades to be different. Upon the successful completion of OnRamps Biology, the student will earn 4 college credit hours (3 lecture + 1 lab). It is equivalent to Texas College Biology Course 1306.

Most class information, assignments, readings, tests, etc. will be available through Canvas through the University of Texas. Each student will have 2 Canvas Classes to work in (1 college lecture, 1 college lab) through OnRamps. The first few weeks of school, we will spend time enrolling and setting up the students in OnRamps.

Please note that the college portion of Onramps has its own syllabus. This syllabus is for high school grades only

High School Grades:

Labs 25%

Daily Grades and Quizzes 15%

Tests 60%

There will also be one semester final (fall and spring) which will count 20% of overall semester grade

Homework:

However, this class requires all note taking, pre lab and post lab assignments and quizzes to be completed outside of class time. Time in class will consist of labs, activities to enhance what is being taught from the notes, peer learning and testing.
