## **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

Biology is designed for students to conduct field and laboratory investigations, use scientific methods during investigations, and make informed decisions using critical-thinking and scientific problem solving. Students in Biology study a variety of topics that include structure and functions of cells and viruses; growth and development of organisms; cells, tissues, and organs; nucleic acids and genetics; biological evolution; taxonomy; metabolism; and energy transfers in living organisms; living systems; homeostasis; ecosystems; and plants and their environment.

#### ABSENT POLICY

The school's policy on absent work will be followed. You have the equivalent of days missed to make up assignments. Students will have advanced notice of tests. If you are absent on a test day you are required to make up the test the following day. The test will be made up during the next day's tutorials or during class. If made up during class time students will be responsible for that day's missed assignments/notes. Students who are missing extra-circular activities will be required to be prepared for class when they return.

## **NOTES**

Students will be required to complete an outline over notes prior to the lecture. I encourage students to develop their note-taking skills this year as it will help them in future advanced courses. Outline notes will be checked for a daily grade. **Incomplete notes will earn students a zero.** The outline notes will be located online on Canvas under files. The notes must be handwritten.

# COMPOSITION NOTEBOOKS AND FRIDAY QUIZZES

Students will be assigned ten prefixes/suffixes and five vocabulary words a week. The prefix/suffix and vocabulary list will be posted on Canvas under the files tab. Students will define all terms in their notebooks every week. The notebooks will be checked every Friday for a daily grade. After the notebooks are checked on Friday for a daily grade, students will take a quiz over the weeks assigned terms.
