Re-Testing
Re-testing is allowed only if a student has failed to show mastery on a test. Students may re-take tests provided they have
completed all assignments. Students will have one week after they failed a test to retake it.
***Re-tests are not allowed for six weeks' tests, mid-terms exams, and final exams. Re-tests are not allowed in Dual Credit courses.

## Absentee Work

Extracurricular Absences - A student involved in an extracurricular activity must notify his or her teacher ahead of time about any absences. If the student is involved in any extracurricular activity, it is the student's responsibility to ask for assignments prior to the absence. The student is still responsible for taking a quiz or test on the assigned date even if the student had an absence prior to the extracurricular activity.
