

Requirements to Attend Project Graduation

- Student must graduate.
- Student must be a graduate of that Spring’s graduating class from Glen Rose Independent School District Campus.
- Any student who receives an assignment of ten or more days for discipline at either the ACE Campus or the High School ISS must appeal to the New Focus Board for consideration before being allowed to attend.
- A student must be enrolled in the Glen Rose High School at the time of the Spaghetti Supper and Auction & **earn at least 15 points.**
- Students must be eligible to attend extra-curricular activities according to discipline guidelines for two weeks prior to graduation.
- Student must attend a mandatory meeting on the day of the Glen Rose High School graduation. The specific time and place will be set and the students informed. If a student does not attend, that student must have their absence approved **prior** to the meeting by Jayden Reynolds. He is the only person who can authorize the absence.
- **Students and parents must sign an understanding of the requirements to attend Project Graduation and return to Jayden Reynolds by February 9, 2024. (You can turn in to GRHS office or GRISD administration building).**
